2020 marks the 14th year of the CHS Caregivers Fund. Thanks to the generosity of employees and friends of CHS, the lifesaving work of fellow caregivers both near and far has been enthusiastically supported, with more than \$1,500,000 distributed to date.

Projects have included RotaCare's free primary care and medication for the underserved in Nassau County, while the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal were also recipients for similar efforts in the Bronx at St. Anthony's Free Clinic. San Diego-based Roads of Success was awarded a grant for humanitarian aid in the Middle East, while the Society of St. Vincent de Paul of Long Island was aided in its dental services outreach. The LJDR Davis Foundation received funding to help provide care for residents of the island nation of Jamaica, and the Catholic Medical Mission Board was a recipient for its health center in Haiti, while a grant was given to the Capuchin Order's Province of St. Mary toward the purchase of a vehicle to transport special needs children. Other recipients include a diocesan mother-baby program in Zaire, fluoride treatments in Honduras, clean water projects in Nigeria and Tanzania, and the Coptic Medical Association of North America's outreach in Ethiopia and Zambia.

Please consider participating in the CHS Caregivers Fund. **CHS donates all administrative costs so that 100% goes to recipients.** Funds are disbursed to health care organizations, with a preference for Catholic organizations, caring for the poor in the U.S. and elsewhere. Funds are used to obtain basic resources for those desperately in need.
