Thanks to the generosity of employees and friends of Catholic Health, the lifesaving work of fellow caregivers both near and far has been enthusiastically supported, with more than \$2,000,000 distributed to date.

Projects have included Roads of Success to support health care for persecuted religious minorities and refugees, while the TZU Chi Foundation provides access of health care to the poor to help India, providing them with oxygen concentrators for patients suffering with COVID-19. The LJD Davis Foundation received funding to provide exams, dispense medication and distribute supplies and equipment for residents of the islands nation of Jamaica while carrying out seven Medical Missions in collaboration with the employees from SFH. A grant was given to Uplift International operated by the Congregation of the Infant Jesus who provides screening and free medications for adults and children while NOVA Hope for Haiti operates two Medical Clinics and provides cervical and breast cancer screening. Capuchin Order's Province of St. Mary's grant provides for construction of the Withdrawal Treatment Ward and related efforts for persons with alcohol use disorder during treatment of detoxification. Amigos de Juanita continues to provide fluoride treatments in Honduras which addresses the urgent problem of tooth decay and assists families with clean water and additional tanks. Over the years 75% of our giving has been International and 25% has been local within the United States.

Please consider participating in the Catholic Health Caregivers Fund. Catholic Health donates all administrative costs so that 100% goes to recipients. Funds are disbursed to health care organizations, with a preference for Catholic organizations, caring for the poor in the US and elsewhere. Funds are used to obtain basic resources for those desperately in need.
