

# 2020 Caregivers Fund Annual Report



In 2020, through the Catholic Health Caregivers Fund, employees continued to assist fellow caregivers in the U.S. and in disadvantaged communities around the globe. Catholic Health donates the costs of administering the fund to ensure that 100% of all donations goes directly to recipients.

**Mission:** We, at Catholic Health, humbly join together to bring Christ's healing mission and the mission of mercy of the Catholic Church expressed in Catholic health care to our communities.

## Recipients and Projects



**\$25,000 Uplift International**  
to provide screening and provision of free medications for adults and children, obtain medical equipment and supplies.



**\$15,000 for Tzu Chi Foundation**  
to provide access to health care and health literacy information, to host events, to promote healthy foods with a nutritionist from St. Francis Hospital & Heart Center® and to administer COVID-19 vaccinations to clinics that serve more than 15,000 patients.



**\$25,000 for RotaCare, Inc.**  
to provide primary medical care and medications. Medicines such as insulin will help improve the quality of health for individuals and families.



**\$15,000 for Roads of Success**  
to send a medical container to Iraq to support the persecuted religious minorities, survivors of genocide, IDPs, refugees and victims of terror.



**\$20,000 for Help Kikwit (Diocese of Kikwit, DRC)**  
to renovate the current maternity unit that is over 60 years old. Restoring walls and floors and acquiring 20 new beds and mattresses for the maternity and delivery room.



**\$25,000 for LJDR Davis Foundation**  
to support seven medical missions in the district of Brando Hill and serving other residents on the island of Jamaica.



**\$5,000 for Amigos de Juanita**  
to continue the expansion of the fluoride program which addresses the urgent problem of tooth decay and assists families with clean water and additional tanks.



**\$15,000 for Province of St. Mary**  
for construction of the Withdrawal Treatment Ward and related efforts for persons with alcohol use disorder during treatment of detoxification.



**\$15,000 for NOVA Hope for Haiti**  
to operate two medical clinics serving 50,000 people, to provide cervical and breast cancer screening, for an agronomy initiative and to provide medication for dental treatments for 200 patients per day.

These grants totaled \$160,000 for 2020, with remaining funds rolled over and incorporated into 2021 donations. Funds are disbursed to health care providers, with a preference for Catholic organizations, caring for the poor in the U.S. and elsewhere.

Contributions to the Catholic Health Caregivers Fund (payable to Catholic Health) is tax deductible for federal income, gift and estate tax purposes, as applicable, to the fullest extent allowed by the law.
