Catholic Health Services (CHS) is an integrated system encompassing some of the region's finest health and human services agencies. With 6 acute care hospitals, 3 nursing homes, a home nursing service, hospice and a community-based agency for persons with special needs, CHS's high standards have resulted in a 24% market share. In 2017, CHS was awarded the Most Wired® designation by the American Hospital Association's Health Forum. CHS has also earned a place in the top 12% of U.S. hospitals, according to the HIMSS Analytics EMR Maturity Model, and has achieved Stage 6 on the HIMSS Analytics Outpatient EMR Adoption ModelSM. All six hospitals are designated stroke centers and have the Get With The Guidelines® (GWTG) Stroke Gold Plus Quality Achievement Award from the American Heart Association (AHA), as well as The Joint Commission's Gold Seal of Approval®. For 2017, CHS was once again the Medal of Honor title sponsor of the Suffolk County Marathon and the race's official provider of medicine.

St. Francis Hospital, The Heart Center®, New York's only specialty designated cardiac center, was ranked one of the Best Hospitals in America by *U.S. News & World Report* for the 11th consecutive year and for 2017-18 is rated "high performing" for 8 common adult procedures and conditions. Also, St. Francis is among just 7% of U.S. hospitals to have earned Magnet® designation. Good Samaritan received its fifth consecutive Outstanding Achievement Award from the American College of Surgeons (ACS) Commission on Cancer (CoC) and is verified as the first Level II Adult and Pediatric Trauma Center on Long Island's south shore, as well. In 2017, St. Catherine and St. Joseph were presented with the HANYS Pinnacle Award for Quality & Patient Safety. Highly accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF), St. Charles earned a place on the AHA's Target: StrokeSM Honor Roll and the GWTG Stroke Gold Plus Quality Achievement Award for the sixth consecutive year in 2016. Mercy was again presented in 2016 with the Pathway to Excellence® designation by the American Nurses Credentialing Center, in addition to Three-Year Accreditation with Gold-Level Commendation and its third consecutive Outstanding Achievement Award from the ACS CoC.

CHS's long-term, sub-acute services include certified home nursing, hospice and rehabilitation, plus residential and day programs for intellectually disabled children and adults, and a behavioral health program. Maryhaven programs have received the highest level of accreditation from CARF. Good Shepherd's leadership was presented with the U.S. Secretary of Defense's Patriot Award. St. Catherine of Siena Nursing & Rehabilitation earned the 2017 CHS Pinnacle Award in the continuing care category, with Catholic Home Care named the finalist. Our Lady of Consolation was named a Top-Performing Nursing Home by the New York State DOH, and, like St. Catherine and Good Samaritan skilled nursing and rehabilitation facilities, it has 5 stars from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services for quality measures.

CHS's longstanding commitment to quality has benefited communities across the region. With more than 4,300 medical staff and 4,000 nurses, approximately 17,500 employees and 1,928 licensed beds, CHS is at the heart of health.
