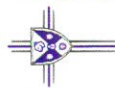

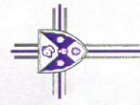

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## Drop-In Program

### Who Are We?

The Drop-In program is an atmosphere where participants with chronic psychiatric illness can feel safe to develop positive, mutual support relationships in a social setting. It addresses the social/recreational needs of its participants and provides weekly activities and social events that allow the individuals to meet and mingle with others, reducing isolation and providing fellowship for all.

The program includes planned activities ranging from baking and creative arts to pizza parties and movies. Additionally, other activities may include but are not limited to: board and card games, music appreciation and a book club. The program also offers an open library and art studio.

**Please Note:** No clinical services are provided.



### Terms and Conditions

- Must live in Nassau County
- Must have a psychiatric diagnosis
- Must be between the ages of 18 to 55
- Must complete application and provide, within the past year, the psychiatry and psychosocial assessments before a screening will be scheduled.

### The Admission Process

Prior to admittance, a current psychiatric, psychosocial is required and a physical and PPD result within one year is preferred. Once this information is received, a screening date will be scheduled.

The participants **MUST** agree to program terms and conditions. Call (516) 632-7980 for an application.



### Lunch

A free lunch is provided to those who have Medicaid. Without Medicaid, lunch will need to be paid for at a set fee

### Transportation

All participants **must** be able to get to the program on their own. Metrocards are provided only to those who have Medicaid. Without Medicaid, Metrocards are to be purchased by the participants in the community.
