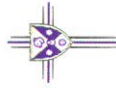

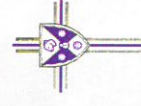

Day Habilitation Program

Individuals interested in learning about the Creative and Performing Arts program will be offered instruction in all aspects of stage performance. Each individual will work collaboratively and artistically through acting workshops and practical "production labs" to produce a series of performances on a seasonal basis.

Area of Study:

Dance

Program participants interested in dance will be offered instructions in musical theater which will culminate in shows and/or workshops featuring the individuals' experiences in this area of instruction.

Set & Costume Design

Individuals who enjoy art and set design will be offered instruction in the technical aspect of theater production. All works produced, whether it is set pieces, props or costumes will be utilized in all productions and workshops.

Voice/ Music

Individuals with a preference for musical study will be offered instructions in voice and instrumental work. All individuals will showcase their talents in productions and workshops.

Acting (Theater & Stage):

For those who enjoy the acting aspect of theater, instruction will be offered to these individuals to work on acting techniques and they will showcase their talents in both productions and workshops.
