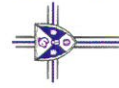

# Recovery House



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## Recovery House

Recovery House is a residential facility for men who are in the recovery process from alcohol and/or substance dependence. We are a 22-bed unit located in Uniondale, New York. We provide a supportive environment in which counseling and rehabilitative services are given to residents, families and significant others. The average length of stay ranges between 6 and 9 months; however this can be individualized based on circumstances and needs. The program is designed to assist residents in their recovery from alcohol/substance abuse problems. Individual residents work to restore or enhance their sense of self and connection to the community in order to establish a productive lifestyle.

### Philosophy

At Maryhaven we view and value the entire person, not just the person's needs. Service plans are centered on the person for whom they are built, with the individual involved in the planning process. An individualized recovery plan is developed for each resident with an emphasis on strengthening independent living skills and encouraging active self help participation. The program encourages successful employment by providing vocational evaluation, education, and training. Short and long term visions for the person's life are developed through a team approach. The goal is to achieve personal outcomes that contribute to and maintain a healthy and satisfying life.

### At Recovery House

A team-centered approach is used to help and support each resident attain the following

- Achieve abstinence
- Gain a better understanding of his disease, spiritual renewal and recovery
- Develop a greater self-awareness, acceptance, and healthy, responsible attitudes toward life

### Services Offered:

- Alcoholism & Substance Abuse Counseling
- Relapse Prevention & Education
- Conflict Resolution/Anger Management
- Vocational Evaluation, Education & Training
- Referrals/Linkages for Medical Care
- Recovery Support Groups
- Referrals to Legal & Financial Services



### Admission Process

Nassau County residents are given preference. While it is preferable for a client to have completed an Inpatient Rehabilitation stay prior to admission, all applicants will be considered for a screening.

Agencies may submit a client's psychosocial, physical, and psychiatric history to Recovery House for review. Referral agencies interested in scheduling screenings can do so by calling:
